

PCS HOA Board Meeting Minutes (7-24-17)

Topics Discussed

President's Report – Bryan Kopp

- Dan Bisher was voted in as a Director by unanimous vote
- Ed Daly was voted in as Treasurer by unanimous vote
- The signature card at GSB will be updated to include Ed Daly as Treasurer.
- The D&O Insurance policy was expiring on July 17th. Allan Breite found a better policy at an annual rate of \$1,251.60. Monies were appropriated from the Great Southern Bank (GSB) account to purchase the insurance since time did not allow for a check to be received from City and Village (C&V), and to avoid a lapse in service. A check was requested from C&V to reimburse the GSB account. Dan Bisher presented the check from C&V that had been mailed to the POBox. Ed Daly will deposit the check into the GSB account.
- Three landscape companies were contacted for bids at the Howell monument. Two agree to
 meet with us. One declined to bid after meeting with us. The other submitted a bid for \$4,395.
 Mike suggested that we have the landscaping installed, except to have the plantings installed in
 early October. Mike made a motion to approved the bid. Seconded by Dan . Approved
 unanimously.
- Minutes from May and June are not ready yet. Mike motioned to table those minutes. Seconded by Ed. Approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report - Dan Bisher + Ed Daly

- Motion made by Dan to table June's report. Seconded by Ed Daly, unanimously approved.
- Ed gave a report on the delinquencies. In the last two months we have received \$2,745.87 from delinquent accounts paying past dues.

Secretary's Report – Bryan Kopp

• Discussion was had regarding the by-laws and how to advertise and fill the open Board positions. This will be revisited at the August meeting.

<u>Grounds & Maintenance Report – Mike Morgan</u>

- The ivy behind the north Howell monument was removed. Seed and straw was installed.
- Locks will be purchased for the newly installed monument outlets.
- One ACC application was received for a fence. The application required additional information before being reviewed.
- A legal letter was received regarding the Howell monument that was hit by a vehicle last year. The Board agreed that the driver's insurance company paid for the damaged monument and grounds, and they therefore declined to take further action against the driver.

<u>Social Events – Bryan Kopp + Mike Morgan</u>

 Fishing Derby expenditures were discussed. Three \$20 prized are offered for each of the three age brackets, totaling \$180. Mike will order fish for the lake, the amount to not exceed \$620.
 Dan suggested further advertising the event.
