

Lake Assessment – November 2023

Lake 1: Small Lake

At the time of my visit in November the lake was milky, slightly green looking. OK. There were a lot of likely migrating geese visiting the lake. Nutrient levels were low again this month – good.

Lake 2: Large Middle Lake

At the time of my visit the lake was milky brownish looking again this month. – OK. Nutrient levels were low again for phosphorous, and nitrogen levels that were very high in October are low this month. That is very good. Although nutrient levels in this lake are typically low (good). A few Water Hyacinth plants were observed near the outfall of the lake. These plants can be invasive and become excessive. They were likely introduced to the lake by someone releasing them from an aquarium or backyard water garden.

Lake 3:

At the time of my visit Lake Superior was milky slightly blackish looking – OK. Nutrient levels were excessive for phosphorous and high for nitrogen this month. We will want to watch this next month.
