

Lake Assessment – August 2023

Lake 1: Small Lake

At the time of my visit the lake was milky black looking. OK. Nutrient levels were elevated for phosphorous this month. Nitrogen levels were low and good. No unwanted aquatic plant development.

Lake 2: Large Middle Lake

At the time of my visit the lake was milky brownish looking. OK. Nutrient levels were low and good.

Lake 3:

At the time of my visit Lake Superior was milky slightly greenish looking. OK. Nutrient levels were high for phosphorous and ok for nitrogen.

Some Willow Trees have established along some of the lake shores. Although generally not a problem they can spread if not controlled.
