ACC

- Diane reviewed two permit applications and received signatures for approval.
- Discussed the need to restrict the percentage of homes purchased by corporations.

Grounds and Maintenance

- Brandt is offering broken up concrete for fill.
- Pam donated fill dirt from her house project and was put on the pile of dirt near Lake Pershing. It will be used on the washouts.
- Some residents are taking care of medians by their homes. Thank you! Some have asked us to tell Putnam not to spray along the edge of the upper medians.
- Two possible dead trees were reported by a resident at 307 on PC South. Mike and Jerry will check it out.
- Mike cleaned up the large broken limb and other limbs on the tree by PC South on Lake Superior. Hauled several gator loads of limbs, etc. to the burn piles around Lake Pershing.

- Mike sprayed the weeds around the monuments and began repairing the concrete edgers around the monuments. Purchased 36 more edgers to replace the broken ones around the monuments. Will put mulch down when the edgers are done.
- Mike filled in the two large washouts on the egg hunt area and also put dirt and rock along the entrance to Lake Pershing.
- Putnam has agreed to deal with the eight dead trees on the egg hunt area this fall. Will mark the trees before work begins.
- AT&T has repaired the washout around their utility box near Lake Pershing spillway.
